## Definitions

1. "Personal data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"); identifiable by a natural person who, directly or indirectly, in particular by virtue of one or more factors such as name, number, position, online identification or physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of the natural person identified;
2. "Data management" means any operation or combination of operations, whether automatic or not, carried out on personal data or data files, such as collection, recording, filing, sorting, storing, transforming or altering, retrieving, accessing, using, communicating, distributing or otherwise making available, reconciling or linking, limiting, deleting or destroying;
3. "Controller" means the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body which alone or jointly with others determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data; where the purposes and means of data processing are determined by Union or Member State law, the controller or the specific criteria for designating the controller may be defined by Union or Member State law;
4. "Processor" means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body which processes personal data on behalf of the controller;
5. "Recipient" shall mean any natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body to whom or to whom personal data are disclosed, whether a third party or not. Public authorities which have access to personal data in the framework of an individual investigation in

accordance with Union or Member State law shall not be considered as recipients; the processing of such data by these public authorities must comply with the applicable data protection rules in accordance with the purposes of the processing;

6. "Consent of the data subject" means the voluntary, explicit and unambiguous expression of the will of the data subject, by which the data subject, by means of a statement or act of unequivocal confirmation, indicates his or her consent to the processing of personal data concerning him or her;
7. "Data incident" means a breach of security that results in the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure or unauthorized access of personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed.

## Principles governing the processing of personal data

Your personal information:

1. its administration must be conducted in a lawful and fair manner and in a manner that is transparent to the data subject ('legality, due process and transparency');
2. collected for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes and not furthered in a way incompatible with those purposes; further processing of data for archiving purposes in the public interest, for scientific and historical research or for statistical purposes ("purpose limitation") shall not be considered incompatible with the original purpose, in accordance with Article 89 (1);

3. they must be appropriate and relevant to the purposes for which the data are processed and must be limited to what is necessary ('data-saving');
4. they must be accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date; every reasonable step must be taken to ensure that personal data which are inaccurate for the purposes of the processing are immediately deleted or rectified ('accuracy');
5. it must be kept in a form which permits identification of data subjects for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data are processed; personal data may be stored for a longer period only if they are processed for archiving in the public interest, for scientific and historical research purposes or for statistical purposes in accordance with Article 89 (1). subject to the implementation of appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect its freedoms ("limited storage");
6. shall be handled in such a way as to ensure adequate security of personal data by appropriate technical or organizational measures, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing, accidental loss, destruction or damage to the data ('integrity and confidentiality').

The controller is responsible for compliance with the above and must be able to justify such compliance ("accountability").

## Using Google Ads Conversion Tracking

1. The controller uses the online advertising program "Google Ads" and uses Google's conversion tracking service. Google Conversion Tracking is a service provided by Google Inc. (1600 Amphitheater Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA; "Google").
2. When a User accesses a web page through a Google ad, a conversion tracking cookie is placed on your computer. These cookies are limited in their validity and do not contain any personal information and cannot be identified by the User.
3. When the User browses certain pages of the Website and the cookie has not expired, Google and the Data Controller may also see that the User has clicked on the advertisement.

## Rights of data subjects

### **1. Right of access**

You have the right to receive feedback from the controller as to whether your personal data is being processed and, if so, to have access to the personal data and information listed in the Regulation.



## **2. Right of rectification**

You have the right, upon request, to rectify any inaccurate personal information concerning you without undue delay. Given the purpose of your data processing, you have the right to request that any personal information that is incomplete be completed, including by way of a supplementary statement.

## **3. Right to Cancel**

You have the right to delete personal data relating to you without undue delay upon your request and the data controller is obliged to delete personal data concerning you without undue delay under certain conditions.

## **4. The Right to Forget**

If the controller discloses personal data and is required to delete it, it shall, taking into account the technology available and the cost of implementation, take reasonable steps, including technical measures, to inform the controllers that you have requested the personal data in question. links or the duplicate or duplicate of this personal information.

## **5. The right to restrict data management**

You have the right, at your request, to restrict the data management if any of the following conditions are met:

- You dispute the accuracy of your personal information, in which case the limitation applies to the period of time that allows the controller to verify the accuracy of your personal information;
- the data processing is unlawful and you object to the deletion of the data and instead request that their use be restricted;

- the controller no longer needs personal data for the purposes of data processing, but you request it for the purpose of making, enforcing or defending legal claims;
- You have objected to the data management; in this case, the limitation applies to the period until it is determined whether the controller's legitimate reasons take precedence over your legitimate reasons.

## **6. The right to data portability**

You have the right to receive personal data about you made available to a data controller in a structured, widely used, machine-readable format, and to transmit such data to another data controller without being hindered by the data controller to whom provided personal information (...)

## **7. Right to protest**

In the case of data processing based on a legitimate interest or a power of attorney as a legal authority, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data, including profiling based on those provisions, for reasons related to your situation.

## **8. Protest against direct sales**

If your personal data is being processed for the purpose of direct marketing, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you for this purpose, including profiling, if it is related to direct marketing. If you object to the processing of your personal data for the purpose of direct marketing, your personal data may no longer be processed for this purpose.

## **9. Automated decision making on individual matters, including profiling**

You have the right not to be subject to any decision based solely on automated data management, including profiling, that would have legal effect or be significantly affected by it.

The preceding paragraph shall not apply if the decision:

- Necessary for the conclusion or performance of a contract between you and the controller;
- it is made possible by Union or national law applicable to the controller, which also lays down appropriate measures to protect your rights and freedoms and legitimate interests; or
- It is based on your explicit consent.

## Deadline for action

The controller shall inform you without undue delay, but in any event within one month of receipt of the request, of the action taken on these requests.

It may be extended by 2 months if necessary. The controller shall inform you of the extension of the deadline, indicating the reasons for the delay, within one month of receipt of the request.

If the controller does not act on your request, it shall inform you without delay, but no later than one month after the receipt of the request, of the reasons for the non-action and of your being able to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.

## Data Security

The controller and the processor shall take appropriate technical and organizational measures, taking into account the state of the art and technology and the costs of its implementation, as well as the nature, scope, circumstances and purposes of the processing and the varying likelihood and severity of the rights and freedoms of natural persons, to guarantee a level of data security appropriate to the degree of risk, including, where appropriate:

1. pseudonymisation and encryption of personal data;
2. ensuring the continued confidentiality, integrity, availability and resilience of systems and services used to process personal data;

3. in the event of a physical or technical incident, the ability to restore access to, and availability of, personal data in a timely manner;
4. a procedure for periodically testing, evaluating and evaluating the effectiveness of technical and organizational measures taken to ensure security of data processing.
5. The data processed must be stored in such a way that no unauthorized person has access to them. In the case of paper-based media, the establishment of a physical storage and filing system, and in the case of electronic data, a central authorization system.
6. The way in which data is stored by IT shall be chosen such that it can be deleted at the end of the period of deletion or, if otherwise necessary, taking into account the different deletion periods. The deletion must be irreversible.
7. Paper-based media must be deprived of personal information with the help of a shredder or an external, specialized shredder. In the case of electronic media, physical destruction of the electronic media and, where necessary, prior deletion of the data in a secure and irreversible manner shall be ensured.
8. The controller shall take the following specific data security measures:

To ensure the security of personal data processed on paper, the Service Provider shall take the following measures (physical protection):

9. Store documents in a safe, well-locked, dry room.
10. Where paper-based personal data is digitized, the rules applicable to digitally stored documents shall apply.
11. The Data Processing Officer of the Service Provider may only leave the premises where data management takes place by locking the data media entrusted to him or by closing the room in question.
12. Personal data may only be accessed by authorized persons and may not be accessed by third parties.

13. The building and premises of the Service Provider are equipped with fire protection and property protection equipment.

## IT Protection

14. The computers and mobile devices (other data carriers) used for data management are the property of the Service Provider.
15. The computer system containing personal data used by the Service Provider is virus-protected.
16. The Service Provider uses data backups and archives to ensure the security of digitally stored data.
17. The central server machine can be accessed only by duly authorized persons.
18. Data on computers can only be accessed with a username and password.

## Informing the data subject about the privacy incident

If the data protection incident is likely to pose a high risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons, the controller shall inform the data subject without undue delay.

The information provided to the data subject shall clearly and unambiguously state the nature of the data protection incident and the name and contact details of the data protection officer or other contact person providing further information; a description of the likely consequences of a privacy incident; the measures taken or planned by the controller to remedy the privacy incident, including, where appropriate, measures to mitigate any adverse consequences that may result from the privacy incident.

The data subject need not be informed if any of the following conditions are met:

- the controller has implemented appropriate technical and organizational security measures and has been applied to the data affected by the data security incident, in particular measures such as the use of encryption which make it unintelligible to unauthorized persons to have access to personal data. data;
- the controller has taken further measures following the data protection incident to ensure that the high risk to the data subject's rights and freedoms is no longer likely to materialize;
- information would require a disproportionate effort. In such cases, the data subjects shall be informed through publicly available information or similar measures shall be taken to ensure that the data subjects are provided with equally effective information.

If the controller has not already informed the data subject about the data protection incident, the supervisory authority, after considering whether the data protection incident is likely to present a high risk, may order the data subject to be informed.

## Report a privacy incident to the authority

The data controller shall notify the data protection incident to the supervisory authority competent pursuant to Article 55 without undue delay and, if possible, no later than 72 hours after becoming aware of it, unless the data protection incident is unlikely to endanger the rights of individuals. and your freedoms. If the notification is not made within 72 hours, the reasons for the delay shall be included.

# Review in case of mandatory data management

Unless specified by law, local government decree or mandatory European Union law, the duration or periodic review of mandatory data processing shall be reviewed by the data controller at least every three years from the start of the processing of personal data is necessary for the purpose of data management.

The circumstances and results of this review shall be documented by the Controller and shall be retained by the Controller for a period of ten years following the completion of the review and shall be made available to the Authority upon request by the National Data Protection and Freedom of Information Authority.

# Remarks

During the preparation of this prospectus we have observed the following legal acts:
